Marriage	Opposes HB444 ⁱⁱ "I would have voted against House Bill 444 because I believe that marriage should be between a man and a woman, and also that this is the consensus of the people in my district." ⁱⁱⁱ	In 2009 Co-introduced HB878 , that changes the language of marriage between a man and woman, to a marriage between two persons. ^{iv} Voted for and co-introduced HB444 ^v
Fiscal Responsibility	" Increasing the general excise tax to balance the budget and increase the cost of necessities such as food, gas, medical care, and other essentials for the families of Hawaii is not looking out for the people and is not wise stewardship of resources. " ^{vi}	In 2009, voted for SB1111 which increases transient tax by 2% (aka Hotel tax) ^{vii} Voted for HB 1907 , which limits contributions you can make to churches. ^{viii} Voted for HB2421 , "Barrel tax" increase that raises electricity costs and gas prices from \$0.05 to \$1.05 ^{ix} Voted for SB2159 , which increases the fee for a traffic abstract from \$7 to \$20, and increases the amount of the fee deposited into the general fund from \$5 to 18! ^x
Abortion	Pro-Life and against physician assisted suicide. ^{xi} Against forcing religious hospitals offering emergency contraceptives to sexually assaulted victims. ^{xii}	In 2006 voted for SB2166 , which allows minors under certain circumstances to consent to provision of medical care and services (including abortion). ^{xiii} In 2006, voted for and co-introduced HB1242 , which expands the definition of abortion to include 2 nd and 3 rd trimester abortion ^{xiv} In 2009, voted for HB423 , which forces religious hospitals to provide information, and emergency contraception, if requested. ^{xv}
