Like all families the government must tighten its belt too.” ^v	In 2009, voted NO for SB1111 which increases transient tax by 2% (aka Hotel tax) ^{vi} Voted for HB 1907 , which limits contributions you can make to churches. ^{vii} Voted for HB2421 , “Barrel tax” increase that raises electricity costs and gas prices from \$0.05 to \$1.05 ^{viii} Voted for SB2159 , which increases the fee for a traffic abstract from \$7 to \$20, and increases the amount of the fee deposited into the general fund from \$5 to 18! ^{ix}
