Marriage	Would oppose HB444 ⁱ "I am a father of two young children and I know that HB444 is an attack on the family unit, and that includes an attack on my family." ⁱⁱ	In 2009 Co-introduced HB878 , that changes the language of marriage between a man and woman, to a marriage between two persons. ⁱⁱⁱ Co-introduced and voted for HB444 ^{iv} Did not respond to Hawaii Family Forum survey - a pro-family organization ^v
Fiscal Responsibility	"I do not support any increase on any tax, because our families cannot afford a tax increase at this time. The states focus should be on what it has and how to maintain them without any more cuts or loss of jobs. I support initiatives that will boost the economy and promote business ventures that will create jobs." ^{vi}	In 2009, voted NO for SB1111 which increases transient tax by 2% (aka Hotel tax) ^{vii} Voted for HB 1907 , which limits contributions you can make to churches. ^{viii} Co-introduced and voted for HB2421 , "Barrel tax" increases that raises electricity costs and gas prices from \$0.05 to \$1.05 ^{ix} Voted against SB2159 , which increases the fee for a traffic abstract from \$7 to \$20, and increases the amount of the fee deposited into the general fund from \$5 to 18!
Abortion	Against forcing religious hospitals offering emergency contraceptives to sex assault victims. ^x	In 2009, voted for HB423 , which forces religious hospitals to provide information, and emergency contraception, if requested. ^{xi} Did not respond to Hawaii Family Forum survey - a pro-family organization ^{xii}
