Marriage	Would oppose HB444 ⁱⁱ "I absolutely oppose HB444. Homosexual marriage is NOT an issue of rights. It is about a small, radical minority trying to legislatively force the redefinition of Traditional Marriage" ⁱⁱⁱ	Opposed HB444 ^{iv} Would vote for a civil union bill that would give same-sex couples the exact same parental rights as married couples with respect to adoption and child custody. ^v
