<b>Marriage</b>	Would oppose <b>HB444</b> . <sup>i</sup>	Voted for <b>HB444</b> <sup>ii</sup> Did not respond to Hawaii Family Forum Survey - a pro-family organization <sup>iii</sup>
<b>Fiscal Responsibility</b>	<p>"Freezing all state grants-in-aid to non-profit organizations."<sup>iv</sup></p> <p>"Repeal all state special funds and the taxes funding them and the return of their full value to Hawaii taxpayers"<sup>v</sup></p> <p>"The state should spend what it already has on a budget before asking to raise taxes."<sup>vi</sup></p>	<p>In 2009, voted for <b>SB1111</b> which increases transient tax by 2% (aka Hotel tax)<sup>vii</sup></p> <p>Voted for <b>HB 1907</b>, which <b>limits contributions you can make to churches.</b><sup>viii</sup></p> <p>Voted for <b>HB2421</b>, "Barrel tax" increase that raises electricity costs and gas prices from \$0.05 to \$1.05<sup>ix</sup></p> <p>Voted for <b>SB2159</b>, which <b>increases the fee for a traffic abstract</b> from \$7 to \$20, and increases the amount of the <b>fee deposited into the general fund</b> from \$5 to 18!<sup>x</sup></p>
<b>Abortion</b>	<p>Against physician-assisted suicide<sup>xi</sup></p> <p>Against forcing religious hospitals offering emergency contraceptives to sexually assaulted victims<sup>xii</sup></p>	In 2009, voted for <b>SB 604</b> , which forces religious hospitals to provide information, and emergency contraception, if requested. <sup>xiii</sup>
